Limitations: Authorized to approve major repairs on APU hardware exclusive of installation requirements and hardware, life-limited parts, parts affected by airworthiness directives, and APU Control Systems. The DER should ensure that the data meets the performance standards or airworthiness requirements of the original type design approval (i.e., Parts 23, 29, or 25) and for TSO'd APU's, does not invalidate the conformance to the TSO.

Special Function: Multiple Use Repairs, Major Alteration; Major Repair; RS-DER.

This letter serves as your Certificate of Authority and should be retained for your use and should be safely filed where it is available to you and the FAA.
